(a) To examine the current status of the VSE sector in India in the global context, assess its strengths and weaknesses, identify the corresponding opportunities and threats and, keeping in view the general approach of the Eleventh Plan to this sector (including the objectives relating to the desired rate of growth of the sector, accelerated employment generation, poverty alleviation, equitable distribution of economic benefits and balanced regional growth) and the recommendations of the Working Group in this behalf and to suggest appropriate measures for facilitating the growth and development of the sector and enhancing its competitiveness at the regional as well as global levels. Conta. 5]_

- (b) In keeping with (a) above and taking into account the recommendations of the Working Group, to critically appraise the strengths and weaknesses of the ongoing Plan schemes/programmes, suggest necessary changes therein and/or formulation of new schemes/programmes and also the methodology and parameters for quantification of the deliverables of each such scheme/programme so as to enable monitoring of its output/outcome vis a vis corresponding objective(s) and allocated resource(s).
- (c) To suggest, in particular, specific measures, including new initiatives, to address the critical concerns of technology upgradation, credit access and associated costs, delayed payments, marketing support in respect of raw materials and outputs/products for domestic and export markets, capacity building and empowerment at enterprise as well as association/cluster levels and protection of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR).
- (d) To assess the present status of the State-level Government and parastatal organizations established for promotion and development of the sector, existing mechanisms of their coordination with the corresponding Central Organisations and the efficacy of these linkages and suggest measures for strengthening the role of the former and bringing about closer synergy with the latter.
- (e) To identify key areas of Public-Private Partnership for growth and development of the sector and to suggest implementation measures for improving sustainability.
- (f) To review the status of the available database of the sector and suggest measures for preparation of a comprehensive database and its periodical updating.
- (g) Any other issue with the permission of the Chairperson.
- 3. The Chairperson may constitute Working Groups/Sub-groups as may be considered necessary and also co-opt members for specific inputs.
- 4. The expenditure on TA/DA in connection with the meetings of the Steering Committee in respect of the official members will be borne by their respective Ministry/Department. However, in the case of non-official members, they will be entitled for TA/DA as admissible to Grade-I officers of the Government of India as per SR 190(a) and the expenditure in this regard would be borne by the Planning Commission.
- 5. The Steering Committee will be serviced by the VSE Division, Planning Commission.
- 6. The Steering Committee would submit its report before 30th September, 2006.
