III. The Terms of Reference of the Steering Committee:

- (i) To review the progress of work of each of the Working Groups set up for the Twelfth Plan for the Transport Sector.
- (ii) To consider the final reports of the Working Groups and take a view on their recommendations.
- (iii) To propose a comprehensive strategy for development of Transport Sector for the country of the Twelfth Plan. In formulating such a strategy the Committee will:
 - a) Consider transport system as an integrated structure.
 - b) Identify major constraints/bottlenecks.
 - c) Define short and long term objectives.
 - d) Draw upon best international practices for providing transport infrastructure and services.
 - e) Identify action areas and priorities and
 - f) Recommend measures for stepping up private sector participation for development of the sector.
- (iv) To suggest organizational, administrative, fiscal and regulatory measures required for planning, implementing, monitoring and evaluating programmes formulated for giving effect to relevant components of the proposed transport strategy for the Twelfth Plan.
- (v) To suggest measures for financing the Transport Sector keeping in view the funding required over the Twelfth Plan period.

3. The Chairman may constitute various Specialists Groups/Sub-Groups/Task Forces as considered necessary and co-opt other members to the Steering Committee for specific inputs.

4. The expenditure towards TA/DA in connection with the meetings of the Steering Committee/Working Groups in respect of the official members will be borne by their respective Ministries/Departments. Thereafter, the Ministry concerned may raise debit claims against Ministry of Planning followed by copies of vouchers (paid) etc. In case of Non-official members of the Steering Committee/Working Groups, expenditure towards their TA/DA would be met by the Planning Commission as admissible to the Class-I officers of the Government of India.

5. The Steering Committee shall submit its report to the Planning Commission within 2 months of receiving the Reports of various Working Groups/sub-Groups on Transport.
