Challenges

- Isolation, 'frog-in-the-well' existence
- Weak knowledge of and engagements with government's programmes
- Inadequate capacity for professional ways of working
- Not addressing the mobilization and empowerment needs of the poor
- Ignoring women's issues—education, health, livelihood, security, etc
