

TENDER NOTICE

1. Sealed tenders are invited for providing housekeeping and facility management services in Planning Commission, Yojana Bhawan, New Delhi.
2. Interested firms/companies/agencies may visit / inspect the site on any working day between 3.00 p.m. to 4.30 p.m before 10/01/2011.
3. The Sealed quotations with separate Technical and Financial bids filled in the specified proforma shall be kept in another sealed envelop. The envelops containing Technical and Financial bids and also the main envelop in which Technical and Financial bids will be kept must be superscribed 'Tender for providing housekeeping and facility management service in Planning Commission'.
4. The envelop containing Technical and Financial bid may be dropped in the Tender box placed at the Reception area of Yojana Bhavan, Parliament Street, New Delhi on **12/01/2011 between 10.00 AM to 3.00 PM.**

6. The Technical bids shall be opened at 3.30 PM on 12.01.2011 (Wednesday) in Room No. 344, Yojana Bhavan, Sansad Marg, New Delhi in the presence of such tenderers or their authorized representatives who may wish to be present.
7. The tenderers whose Technical bids are accepted will be informed about the date of the opening financial bid.
8. Bids received after the closing date and time shall not be considered under any circumstances.

Eligibility Criteria

1. The firms/companies/agencies should have Registered/Branch Office in Delhi/NCR
2. The bidder should have at least three years experience in housekeeping in Ministries/Departments of Govt. of India/Public Sector Undertakings/Autonomous bodies/Banks/Airport/Corporate houses etc. The details of the contract viz. name and address of the Ministries/Departments/Public Sector Undertakings/Autonomous bodies/Banks/airports./corporate houses with telephone no. and copies of the agreement/work order must be enclosed with the Technical bid.
3. The bidder should have at least two running contracts with Ministries/departments of Central Govt/Public Sector Undertakings/Autonomous bodies/Airport/Banks Corporate houses as on date of opening of tender with annual contract value of Rs. 8,00,000/- (Rupees. Eight Lakhs) per annum.
4. The bidder must be registered with EPF, ESIC and service Tax department and copy of the same should be enclosed with Technical bids.
5. The bidder must have been registered with Labour Commissioner, Delhi & should have a valid labour license.
6. The bidder should not have been blacklisted by any Government organization/Public Sector Undertakings/Autonomous bodies/Banks etc. A self certificate on the letter head to this effect should be enclosed with the Technical Bid.
7. The bidder shall have a valid labour license and license for providing Pest control services which should be valid for at least 18 months from January-2011.

“Evaluation Criteria”

8. The tenderers are required to submit two separate bids - Technical and Financial, as per prescribed Performa enclosed with tender notice. The two bids should be submitted in two separately sealed envelopes superscribed “**Technical Bid for House Keeping Services in Planning Commission**” and “**Financial Bid for House Keeping Services in Planning Commission**” respectively. Both sealed envelopes will be put in a third sealed envelope superscribed “**Tender for House Keeping Services in Planning Commission**”.
9. All mandatory and necessary documents, certificates, declaration in the prescribed proforma enclosed with the tender notice should be submitted alongwith the Technical bid.
10. The Technical bid shall be accompanied by an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One only) in the form of Demand Draft/Pay Order from a commercial bank drawn in favor of “**Pay & Accounts Officer, Planning Commission, New Delhi**”. It shall remain valid for a period of six months. The tender not accompanied with EMD shall be rejected summarily. The earnest money shall be refunded to the unsuccessful bidders after finalization of the contract. It shall be refunded to the successful bidder on receipt of performance security deposit. No interest is payable on the EMD.
11. All entries in the tender form should be legible and filled clearly. No overwriting or cutting is permitted in the Financial Bid Form. In such cases, the tender shall be summarily rejected. However, cuttings, if any, in the Technical Bid must be initialed by the person authorized to sign the tender bids. Conditional bids will not be considered and will be rejected outright.
12. Tender incomplete in any form will be rejected outright.
13. The bidder shall submit following documents with Technical Bid:-
 - Copy of Labour License.
 - Copy of EPF Registration certificate.
 - Copy of ESIC Registration certificate.
 - Copy of Service Tax Registration certificate.
 - Copy of PAN number.
 - Certificate to the effect that the firm is not blacklisted.
 - Copies of experience certificate/work order for the last three years.

Copy of at least two similar running contracts with Central Government departments/ Public Sector Undertakings/Autonomous bodies/Banks/airports etc.

Earnest Money Deposit (EMD of Rs. 1,00,000/- in the form of Bank Draft/Pay order drawn in favour of **Pay and Accounts Officer, Planning Commission, Payable at New Delhi.**

14. The closing date and time for receipt of tenders will be **3.00 P.M. on 12.01.2011 (Wednesday)**.

15. The Technical bid shall be opened at **3.30 PM on 12.01.2011 (Wednesday)** in Room No. 344, Planning Commission, Yojana Bhavan, Sansad Marg, New Delhi, in the presence of the authorized representatives of the Firms, who wish to be present at that time. All the technical bids will be scrutinized, relevant documents checked for their authenticity and the tenderers whose Technical bids are accepted will be informed about the date and time for opening the Financial Bids.

16. No bidder will be allowed to withdraw after submission of the bids, otherwise the EMD submitted by the bidding firm would stand forfeited. In case, the successful bidder declines the offer of contract, for whatsoever reason(s), his EMD will be forfeited.

17. The successful tenderer will have to deposit a Performance Security Deposit @ 8% of contract value by way of Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) from a commercial bank and hypothecated in favour of **"Pay & Accounts Officer, Planning Commission, New Delhi"** and valid for 60 days beyond the expiry of period of one year of the contract. In case of extension of contract fresh Performance Security Deposit will have to be deposited.

18. The bidder whose total rate quoted in the Financial Bid towards wages of Housekeeping supervisor/Workers, charges, if any, for Machines and Equipments, toilets and dispensers, cleaning material and aids, pest control etc are the lowest in comparison to other bidders will be considered as the lowest bidder.

Other terms & conditions

19. The bidder shall submit a complete list of items / equipments that will be used for the housekeeping services.

20. The bidder will be responsible for supply / installation / refilling / maintenance of all such items / equipments used in wash rooms and other areas for housekeeping purposes.

21. The bidder must employ adult and unskilled labour only. Employment of child labour will lead to the termination of the contract. The successful bidder shall engage only such workers, whose antecedents have been thoroughly verified, including character and police verification and other formalities. A list of such persons along with their police verification report should be submitted within 15 days after award of contract to this Commission.

22. The bidder shall deal with and settle the matters related with worker unions and shall make sure that no labour disputes/problems are referred to Planning Commission. The successful bidder firm should indemnify Planning Commission in this regard.

23. The bidder at all times should indemnify Planning Commission against all claims, damages or compensation under the provisions of Payment of Wages Act, 1936; Minimum Wages Act, 1948; Employer's Liability Act, 1938; the Workmen Compensation Act, 1923; Industrial Disputes Act, 1947; Maternity Benefit Act, 1961; Delhi Shops and Essential Act or any modification thereof or any other law relating thereto and rules made hereunder from time to time. Onus to comply with these laws/Rules made thereunder is the sole responsibility of the firm/bidders and Planning Commission will not own any responsibility in this regard.

24. Any increases in the wages of manpower deployed in the Planning Commission will be considered in accordance with revision of minimum wages by NCT of Delhi from time to time.

25. The successful bidder will have to commence the work within 15 days of acceptance of contract. Otherwise the contract will be cancelled and EMD will be forfeited.

26. The Scope of Work is for the complete area on 3rd floor, fourth floor and fifth floor including top roof etc. The details of the work are given at Annexure 'A'.

27. The list of Machinery and Equipments, Details of toiletries/dispensers etc and list of cleaning Materials and Aids to be provided by the bidder are detailed at Annexure 'B', 'C' and 'D' respectively. These should be provided within 15 days from the date of award of contract. Any delay thereafter shall invite a penalty @ Rs.500/per day.
28. The contract shall initially be valid for a period of one year and may be extended further on a yearly/half yearly basis subject to satisfactory performance, on the same terms & conditions upto a maximum period of three years. It shall be the sole responsibility of the bidders to provide all the safety gear/mask/gloves/gum boots etc to its worker deployed for housekeeping and for pest control in Yojana Bhavan and any injury or harms is caused to any worker/manpower due to non providing of such safety gear etc, it shall be the sole responsibility of the firm and Planning Commission will not be responsible and shall stand indemnified.
29. If any worker arrives late (or leaves early) but permitted to perform duty, pro-rata deduction of the duty rate would be made on hourly basis. If a person deployed is absent on a particular day or comes late/leaves early on three occasions, one day's wage shall be deducted. However, no habitual late comer would be allowed to work and it will be the responsibility of the service provider to provide a substitute.
30. If a worker proceeds on leave or leaves the job, it will be the responsibility of the agency to provide a substitute immediately. In case substitute is not provided, deduction of charges will be made on a pro-rata basis from the monthly bills. Further, if a substitute is not provided within 3 days, deduction @ double the charges per worker will be made.
31. It should be made clear to the manpower so deployed by the successful bidder as per the tender that no employer/worker/employee/relationship is established between the Commission or the Government of India and workers by virtue of such deployment and no claims for temporary or permanent employment in Govt. service shall be entertained from any or group of such workers.
32. The supervisor of the successful bidder shall check and inspect all the toilets for any water leakage/non functional /missing taps of wash basin and toilets /washrooms and mugs/buckets etc, and check whether the cisterns are in working order and the sheets of western style WCs are not broken/cracked and shall submit an OK report to the Caretaker, Planning Commission. Any tap/WC etc. which require repair etc. should be immediately reported by him in writing to caretaker.
33. In case of breach of any terms and conditions attached to this contract, the Performance Security Deposit of the agency will be liable to be forfeited by this Commission besides annulment of the contract.
34. Staff deployed by the bidder shall perform their duties at the premises with due diligence and take all precautions to avoid any loss or damage to the Government property/person.
35. If any incident of theft/pilferage by the worker of the firm is reported causing pecuniary loss to the Govt., the entire cost will be recovered from the firm besides annulment of the contract.
36. If any action or inaction on the part of workers of the firm causing damage to movable/immovable property of Planning Commission is reported then full amount equivalent to that of damaged article will be recovered from the firm in addition to any other action as deemed appropriate by the competent authority.
37. The firm shall ensure proper decorum, behaviors by the staff engaged for cleaning work during their duty. The workers shall not be allowed to wander in the corridors of Yojana Bhavan without work & personnel so deployed should not smoke and /or play radio/ music within the premises of Yojana Bhavan.
38. The personnel so deployed by the firm should be free from any infectious diseases and should be directed not to loiter in the premises & shall remain confined to their designated duty areas/floors.
39. The firm shall ensure proper delivery of service by the staff so deployed during their duty hours.
40. The contractor shall provide uniform to the workers, samples of uniform will be approved by the Planning Commission. The worker must wear uniform during their duty. The contractor shall issue identity card to each worker which must be displayed by the worker during their duty.

41. The bidder shall provide following manpower for housekeeping services:-

(for ladies toilets the bidder should provide at least 2 female workers)

42. Each page of the tender document should be signed and stamped by bidder in acceptance of the terms and conditions laid down by Planning Commission.

43. If the work of the firm is not found satisfactory, Planning Commission reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time without assigning any reasons and the decision of the Planning Commission will be final and binding on the contractor.

44. The competent authority of Planning Commission reserves the right to reject all or any tender in whole, or in part, without assigning any reason.

45. Payment will be made on monthly basis in the succeeding month on submission of bill in triplicate. Payment of the bill will be based on computerized print outs in standardized proforma alongwith computer generated attendance sheet in respect of persons deployed.

46. Whenever and wherever it is found that the cleanliness is not up to the mark, it will be brought to the notice of the supervisory staff of the bidder by PLANNING COMMISSION and if no action is taken within ONE hour, penalty @ Rs.500/- per day per complaint will be imposed .

47. The bidder should ensure to maintain the required number of manpower and also arrange a pool of stand by housekeeping staff/ supervisor. In case any housekeeping staff/supervisor absent himself from the duty, the reliever of equal status shall be provided by the bidder from the existing pool of housekeeping staff. If the required numbers of workers / supervisor/ manager are less than the minimum required, a penalty @ Rs.500/- per worker per day will be deducted from the bill.

48. Any deviation in the material quality & quantity quoted will invoke penalty @Rs 1000/=per occasion For proper maintenance only suitable cleaning material (ISI mark) which are environment friendly, not harmful to human and government property should be used.

49. The successful bidder should provide liquid soaps in soap dispenser in the toilets and toilet paper rolls at least twice a day and as often as may be required. The soap & toilet paper roll so provided should be of good quality & no diluted or water mixed soap be provided. Any violation on this cannot shall invite penalty @ Rs.500/- per day per fault/violation

50. The firm shall provide manpower on all 6 days, Monday to Saturday from 8.00AM to 5 PM. and also on holidays whenever required at no extra cost. The duty hours may be staggered for providing services beyond 8 hours a day as per labour laws etc. and separate team be provided to relieve the workers who have put in maximum number of work hours.

51. The successful bidder shall pay wages/salary direct to workers in time through Bank accounts. Any dispute arising out of non payment, short payment or delayed payment has to be settled by the contractor and the workers engaged by themselves.

52. Any dispute regarding the contract shall be resolved through arbitrator to be nominated by Competent Authority, Planning Commission. The contract shall be subject to relevant law and the jurisdiction of the courts located in Delhi.

53. PLANNING COMMISSION reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time ,if the services are not found satisfactory and also has the right to award the contract to any other agency at the cost, risk and responsibilities of bidder and excess expenditure incurred on account of this will be recovered by PLANNING COMMISSION from its Security Deposit or pending bills or by raising a separate claim.


54. The housekeeping Manager will maintain a Register and any complaint received from Planning Commission will be noted in the register and necessary action will be taken thereon within 24 hours.

55. As per Govt of India's Notification No. 15/2005 dated 7.6.2005, cleaning services in respect of non-commercial buildings and premises thereof does not come under the purview of Service Tax. Planning Commission being a non-commercial building, Service Tax is not leviable on cleaning services in its office i.e Yojana Bhawan. Therefore, Planning Commission will not pay any service tax for cleaning services provided for Yojana Bhawan.

56. All tendered rates shall be inclusive of all taxes and levies payable under respective statutes. However, pursuant to the Constitution (46th Amendment) Act, 1982, if any further tax or levy is imposed by Statute, after the last stipulated date for the receipt of tender including extensions if any and the contractor thereupon necessarily and properly pays such taxes/levies, the contractor shall be reimbursed the amount so paid, provided such payment, if any, is not, in the opinion of Planning Commission (whose decision shall be final and binding on the contractor) attributable to delay in execution of work within the control of the contractor. The contractor shall furnish the relevant documents regarding payment of such taxes/levies as and when Planning Commission will require from time to time.

Note: Technical and Financial Bid in a single envelop will be out rightly rejected.

Details of work for which contract to be awarded

The following Housekeeping/ cleaning services will be done daily from Monday to Saturday at regular intervals so that the areas covered under the contract remain spic and span all the time. Working hours should be adjusted in such a manner that cleaning work in the morning should be completed well before 9.00 A.M. However bidder will arrange manpower for special VIP visits at no extra cost.

1. Cleaning, dusting, vacuuming and disinfecting of floors, walls and ceilings. Removal of waste and any other garbage from the entire area covered under the contract (such as T.T.hall, canteen, sweets buds, committee rooms, office rooms, toilets, Corridors , shaft , cabins, top roof, cubicles, etc.)
2. Sweeping, cleaning, mopping with disinfectant cleaner of area covered under the contract, including all staircases, cabins, lobbies, top roof , training rooms, office rooms, cabins, meeting rooms, security office on roof and other areas as covered in the contract.
3. Cleaning of baskets, wastepaper baskets, cob-webs, etc. and disposing off all the collected refuse at designated site on daily basis.
4. Dusting of computer systems table, chairs and their peripherals racks, cabinets, almirahs all doors and windows, furniture, fixtures, fans, equipments, accessories etc. and cleaning of all windows glasses and grills. Cleaning and dusting of window panes / venetian blinds.
5. Spraying Room Fresheners in all rooms, as & when asked to do.
6. Scrubbing / cleaning of toilets, wash basins, sanitary fittings, glasses, toilets, floors, etc.
7. Cleaning and disinfecting all vitreous fixtures including toilet bowls, urinals, sinks, toilet seats, containers etc. Brush thoroughly to include below water level and under rims including areas at hinges and cistern handles. Re-stock toiletries, which include liquid hand soap, toilet rolls, air fresheners, sanitary cubes, naphthalene balls in toilets, etc. after daily check-ups in the morning, afternoons and on call basis during daytime.
8. Cleaning and dusting of electrical switchboards, light fixtures, fans, air conditioner vents, overhead light fixtures, projectors, fire-fighting equipments, nameplates, plant boxes, doormats etc.
9. Placing garbage bags in all garbage bins to avoid stains & stinks and clear them on daily basis.
10. Check and remove hairs, dust, dirt or any such object from anywhere in area covered under the contract.
11. Cleaning, dusting, scrubbing of pantries, committee rooms, etc.
12. The garbage will have to be disposed of at least twice a day.
13. The refuse/garbage shall be disposed of at the appropriate garbage point after proper sorting of bio degradable and non bio degradable garbage.
14. Pest control measures mosquito spray, mouse traps, rat traps (no rat poisons is to be used without proper safety measures etc. and prior permission/knowledge of Caretaker, Planning Commission) removal of trapped, live/dead mice/rats etc.
15. Checking mosquito breeding places & employing stagnant water stored/trapped in discarded tanks, utercils/pots, coolers etc.
16. The list is only suggestive & not exhaustive. Any work relates to house keeping can be assigned by Caretaker

Pest & Rodent Control Service

- 1.The bidder shall take effective measures for Rodent and Disinfection Services including fogging etc. on weekly basis in the area under contract.
- 2.The bidder shall use chemicals that are harmless to humans and further, the chemicals should not leave any spots in the treated area.
- 3.The bidder will be responsible for any damage to human/machinery by any chemicals used by him. Any damage caused to machinery/books due to rodent and disinfection services in the areas covered under contract shall be made good by the bidder.
