Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Government of N.C.T. of Delhi's letter No. F.18(8A)/2010-11/Monit./Plg./9322 dated 22.09.2010, on the above subject and to convey the acceptance of Planning Commission to the outlay of Rs. 11,400 crores subject to availability of resources.

- 2. The amounts dealing with the Flagship programmes and the corresponding share of N.C.T. of Delhi that needs to be provided in the UT Plans may be adequately arranged so that the UT may not lose the share of the central assistance for the Centrally Sponsored Schemes.
- 3. The proportion of SC population in Delhi is 16.9% as per 2001 census. As per SCSP guidelines 16.9% i.e. Rs. 1926.6 crore of the total outlay should have been earmarked for the SC Sub-Plan. But in the current proposal of Govt. of N.C.T. of Delhi, no earmarking has been provided for the SC Sub-Plan. The approval is subject to the condition that the Govt. of NCT of Delhi will provide an earmarking of 16.9% of the total plan outlay for the SCSP by the RE stage.
- 4. Under various Major Heads/Minor Heads of the Departments, allocation has been indicated as ACA for Commonwealth Games. In no case these funds should be indicated under SCSP funds.
- 5. A statement showing the distribution of Approved Plan outlay under different heads and sub-heads of development is enclosed.
- 6. Your attention is invited to the procedure for sending adjustment proposal and revision of outlays and request you to send adjustment proposal and proposal for revision of outlays fully supported by the Revised Scheme of Financing (SOF) for the Annual Plan 2010-11, if any, together with appropriate justification, before **February 28, 2011**.
